## Summer 2022 Q&A Children in Schools

- 1. What is the total amount of the Summer 2022 P-EBT Benefit? U.S. standard benefit of \$391 to all eligible children.
- 2. When will the Summer 2022 P-EBT Benefit funds be issued? Tentatively, a single benefit will be issued for the entire summer period between September 1-30, 2022.
- 3. Can you still apply for School Meal Benefits, to receive the Summer 2022 P-EBT Benefit? Yes, Meal Benefit Application Open Enrollment is July 1, 2022-August 31, 2022 for households of children who become newly eligible during the covered summer period. - 4. If your student graduated in May 2022 do they qualify? Yes, high school students that graduated May 2022 and received free and reduced meal benefits qualify for Summer 22 P-EBT.
- 5. If your student is a new Kindergarten student for the 22-23 SY can they apply during open enrollment and qualify for Summer 2022 P-EBT? No, the P-EBT summer program is an extension of P-EBT for school year 2021-2022. Children starting kindergarten in the fall of 2022 are not eligible for P-EBT summer benefits as school children. They may, of course, be eligible for summer child care benefits if they were under age 6 during SY 2021-2022, and are enrolled in SNAP during summer 2022.
- 6. How will I receive my student's Summer 2022 P-EBT funds? Students that received P-EBT benefits for SY 2020-2021 will receive Summer P-EBT benefits on the same EBT card previously issued. Lost Card? 1-800-997-8888. SNAP-enrolled child care children that received P-EBT benefits for SY2021-2022 under the State's P-EBT for Child Care plan, will have Summer P-EBT benefits added to the household's existing EBT card. New EBT cards will be issued for Summer P-EBT to newly eligible households.
