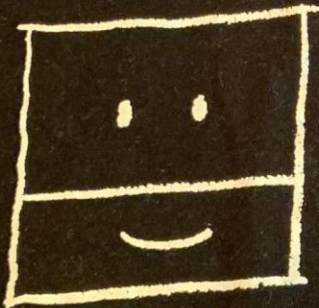

Name the Artist

Leonardo Da Vinci- Italian artist, painted Mona Lisa

Rembrandt- From the Netherlands, painted over 600 paintings, he liked dogs and put them in several paintings, painted very serious faces

Monet- French painter, founder of Impressionism, was all about capturing light & color

Van Gogh- From the Netherlands, one of the most famous painters, painted Starry Night, became famous after his death, cut off his ear!

Picasso- Born in Spain, expressive art called Cubism; artist paints a bottle, objects, different angles all in the same picture

Dali- Spanish artist, Created type of art called Surrealism-meaning strange objects that are out of place

Rothko- Abstract Expressionist, studied at Yale, objects appeared to be floating

Pollock-American abstract expressionist artist, famous for dropping paint expressively over large canvas

Warhol- Famous American POP Artist, likes to use famous people and iconic commercial images and repeat them over and over
