FPMS FAQs

1. When is Open House?

August 3rd-you may come anytime during the two hours allotted for your grade level listed below

a. 8th Grade: 8:00-9:30
b. 7th Grade: 9:30-11:00
c. 6th Grade: 11:00-12:30

*Attending Open House is optional. If you do not attend Open House, your student will receive their schedule and other information on the first day of school. *

2. What is the purpose of Open House?

To reduce exposure and close contact, we have 3 main goals for students at Open House:

- a. Find your homeroom teacher
- b. Pick up your schedule
- c. Meet your teachers

(If you have medications to leave with the nurse, you may also bring those to Open House.)

3. Do I have to fill out paperwork at Open House for my student(s) this year?

Yearly required forms may be picked up at Fort Payne Middle School during the month of July or printed from our website to be completed prior to Open House. Forms will also be available at Open House.

4. What about fees?

We will be using the GoFan website/app to collect activity and novel fees, as well as yearbook money, etc. Check and cash will also be accepted <u>after school begins</u>. More information will be provided at Open House.

5. Will students use lockers this year?

Lockers will be available for students who wish to use one, but not required. The cost is \$5.

6. Are lunches free again this year?

No, free and reduced lunch forms will be available in the cafeteria during Open House for students, as needed. Parents may deposit money into lunch accounts during Open House.

7. Will students use lunch cards again this year?

No, students will use their lunch number to access their lunch account.

8. What supplies does my child need?

9. What if my child needs to ride a bus?
